

Jabra Link 390c MS - USB-C

What do the LEDs on the Jabra Link Bluetooth adapter mean?

Here is an explanation of the LED colours and behaviours.

Off	Bluetooth adapter is not powered	 Off	
Boot	USB power is applied and system is starting up. USB enumeration.	 Off	
Reconnect attempt	Bluetooth radio is searching for the last connected Bluetooth device	 Flash Blue	Duration = 30 sec. Blinking sequence 1 sec. on; 1 sec. off
Automatic pairing*	The Bluetooth radio is automatically searching for new Bluetooth devices for first time use	 Blinking Blue LED	Pairing mode is limited to a duration of 30 sec. Blinking sequence 0.5 sec. on and 0.5 sec. off
Idle	Connected to a Bluetooth device. No audio link active.	 Blue	
Standby	Bluetooth adapter is not connected and is no longer trying to pair. However adapter is connectable for already paired Bluetooth device.	 Off	
Voice link	Link is established for voice call	 Green	
Incoming call	Incoming call	 Flash Green	Blinking sequence 0.1 sec. green; 0.3 sec. off; 0.1 sec. green ; 0.7 sec. off
Music (A2DP) link	Link is established for music streaming	 Cyan	
Mic Mute	Microphone is muted	 Red	
Firmware update	Jabra Link 390 is in firmware update mode	N/A	
Teams notification**	Notification from Teams on computer	 Pulse Purple	Blinking sequence 0.5 sec. on; 0.5 sec. off
Connected to Teams**	Connected to Teams application on computer	 Purple	Teams purple
