

Jabra Engage 65 Convertible

How do I connect my Jabra Engage to my Aastra Open Phone 63 or 65 desk phone so I have remote call control using my headset?

Prerequisites

- Jabra 8800-00-93 Electronic Hook Switch (EHS) cable
- AZ adapter (from Aastra/DeTeWe)
- DeTeWe Open Phone 63 or 65
- OpenCom 100 from software 5.2
- OpenCom 1000 from software 3.2

Connect your headset

- 1. Plug one end of the phone cable supplied with the headset to the socket marked with the phone icon on the Jabra base.
- 2. Plug the other end of included phone cable into the headset port of the AZ adapter.
- 3. Plug one end of the Jabra 8800-00-93 to the AUX port on the Jabra base.
- 4. Plug the hollow socket connector to the socket marked with the bell icon on the AZ adapter.
- 5. Plug the 6-pin western connector into the second receiver socket on the AZ adapter.

Configure your headset when connecting to a desk phone for the first time

- For Jabra Engage 75/75 SE, follow the onscreen setup wizard on the base.
- For Jabra Engage 45 SE/65/65 SE, the initial setup is complete after



connecting the cables.

Additional setup information for your Jabra products

- EHS cable/adapter type: GN1000.
- Clear dial tone switch: set to position "A".
- We recommend setting the microphone volume to "7" out of 13.

Phone settings

- Activate the Remote Headset function on your Open Phone device.
- Navigate to Menu > Settings > Peripherals > Additional device
 selection > Remote Headset.
