

Jabra Engage 75 Stereo

What is the range between my Jabra Engage headset and the base?

The Jabra Engage supports a maximum range of 150 meters/490 feet from the base to the headset. In practice, you may find the range to be somewhat shorter due to physical obstructions such as walls, windows, Wi-Fi, and electromagnetic interference.

The sound in your headset will slowly deteriorate as you move farther away from the base. When you move back in range, the sound quality is restored.

If you move beyond range while talking, you will lose all sound. However, your call will be held open at the base for 2 minutes, which gives you a chance to move back in range. After 2 minutes out of range, the current call will be ended. If you remain out of range for a longer time, you may need to re-establish the DECT connection manually when you return, by docking the headset to the base.
