

Jabra PanaCast USB Hub USB-C

How do I connect the Jabra PanaCast to the Jabra PanaCast Hub?

The following steps will ensure that the Jabra PanaCast Hub* uses wall power and that the Jabra PanaCast gets the correct amount of power.

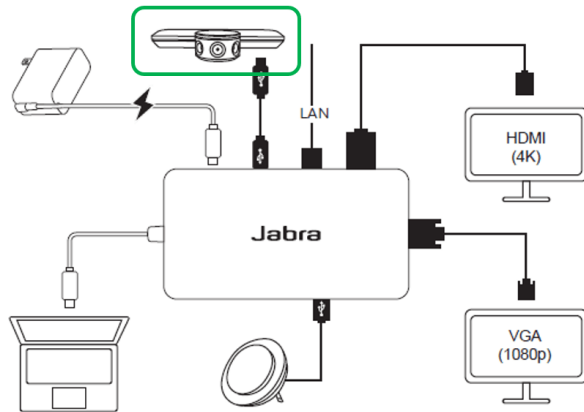
1. Plug the hub's supplied power adapter into a power outlet that is powered on, and connect the adapter to the power jack of the hub.
2. Connect the Jabra PanaCast to the fast charge port on the hub. This port is indicated by a lightning icon.
3. If you are using a Jabra speakerphone, connect it to another USB port on the hub. It is recommended to use a port that is as far away from the Jabra PanaCast as possible.
4. Connect the hub's integrated USB-C cable** to a USB port on the host computer.
5. Start the video conference call.

If the steps are not done in the correct sequence, results may vary. For example:

- If the power adapter is connected after the hub has already been connected to the host computer, power will not be consistently switched from the computer to the wall outlet. Although it may appear that the hub's power is coming from the wall outlet, it may actually be coming from the host computer.
- If the Jabra PanaCast is not connected to the fast charge port, it may not receive adequate power at startup when multiple devices may be powering up simultaneously.

The following diagram shows the Jabra PanaCast connected to the Jabra PanaCast Hub. A Jabra speakerphone, computer, Ethernet connection, HDMI monitor (4K), and VGA monitor (1080p) are also connected to the

hub.



Note

*The Jabra PanaCast Hub is meant to be used with the Jabra PanaCast only—not with other models in the Jabra PanaCast Series.

**The 1m/3ft USB cable is supplied with the Jabra PanaCast Hub. Optionally, you can purchase a longer 1.8m/6ft USB cable.
