

# Jabra PanaCast USB Hub USB-C

## What are the best practices for installing the Jabra PanaCast?

When installing the Jabra PanaCast, follow these guidelines.

- Use only the included 1m/3ft cable or the optional Jabra 1.8m/5.9ft cable.
- Use a USB 3.0 port. Using a USB 2.0 port may result in reduced video quality.
- If you use a USB extender cable or USB hub solution, ensure it is a Jabra approved solution. You can check this information in the [Jabra PanaCast cable guide](#).
- Ensure your Jabra PanaCast camera has the latest firmware. Use Jabra Direct to check for updates and install the latest firmware. Always use the latest version of Jabra Direct as well.
- Some video conferencing applications may provide better video quality if you reduce the viewing video image from the full screen view to a reduced/partial screen view.

### Note

The video conferencing application that is using the Jabra PanaCast camera (such as Zoom, Skype, Webex, GoTo Meeting) may have its own limitations on video quality. This may result in a lesser quality than what the Jabra PanaCast can deliver natively.
