

Jabra Elite Active 75t Wireless Charging - Navy

My Jabra device becomes warm when I charge it using a wireless charger. Is this safe?

While charging your Jabra device using a wireless charger, the device and charger may become warm to the touch. Wireless chargers take longer to fully charge a device, which may result in the device becoming warm. This elevated temperature is within safe operating requirements and has no bearing on the lifespan or performance of the device. Safe operating and storage temperatures for your device can be found in the Technical Specification document under **Product documents**.

When charging your Jabra device, we recommend following these guidelines.

- Do not place foreign materials, such as metal objects, magnets, and magnetic stripe cards, between the Jabra device and the wireless charger.
- Do not place your device in direct sunlight for extended periods, especially when charging.
- Keep the charging port free from foreign objects.
- Do not use a charger if it is wet or damaged.
- Ensure the minimum power is not less than 5 watts.
