

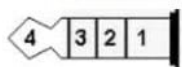
Jabra Evolve 30 II MS Mono

What is the standard of the 3.5mm jack connector on my Jabra headset?

The 3.5mm jack connector for your Jabra headset conforms to the headset standard of the Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association (CTIA). The microphone connector point is on the sleeve end, and the ground connector is on the second ring.

CTIA "AV" connector interface:

Pin	Description
1	Microphone
2	Ground
3	Right earpiece
4	Left earpiece



To ensure full compatibility with your Jabra headset, make sure your device also conforms to the same standard.
