How do I reactivate Google Assistant on my Android phone if I previously chose to not activate it?

Prerequisites
















- Android phone with Google Assistant as the default voice assistant

The first time you pair your Jabra headset with your phone, you are asked to activate Google Assistant. If you choose to not activate it, you cannot select Google Assistant as the voice assistant in Jabra Sound+.

If you decide later that you want to use Google Assistant, follow these steps to reactivate it on your phone.

1. Go to the Bluetooth menu on your phone and delete the Jabra headset pairing.
2. Re-pair your headset with your phone.
3. When prompted, select Activate to enable Google Assistant.
4. Place your earbuds into the charging case and close the lid.
5. Remove your earbuds from the charging case.
6. If the prompt does not display, follow steps 1-5 until the prompt appears.
