How do my Jabra true wireless earbuds reduce ambient noise?

The Jabra Elite 7 Active true wireless earbuds offers the following to reduce ambient noise.

- Four-microphone technology—two microphones placed in each earbud—which point toward the user’s mouth and pick up the voice.
- The four microphones are covered with a fine SAATI Acoustex® mesh for increased wind protection.
- Digital signal processing removes background noise, such as traffic or office noise.
- Passive noise isolation, by means of the shape and fit of the EarGels, blocks out and lowers the level of ambient noise you hear when you wear Jabra true wireless earbuds. Here it is important that the EarGels seal in the ears to give the best results.
- Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) that reduces unwanted low frequency background noise by use of an electronic circuit. You can turn this feature on/off to suit your preference.

Note

True wireless earbuds perform well for music and calls in many different environments. However, the design and wearing style of the earbuds, with the microphones located in the ears rather than next to the mouth, may in some situations present a challenge picking up voice or filtering out background noise, compared with Jabra products that have a different design and wearing style. Other products may offer higher levels of noise reduction on the receiving end of a call because the microphones are placed closer to the mouth, for example in a boom arm or on a cord.
