

Jabra Elite 8 Active Gen 2 - Black

How do I charge my Jabra earbuds and the Smart case?

To charge your Jabra earbuds, place the earbuds in the Smart case and close the lid. It takes up to 3 hours to fully charge the earbuds.

When the Smart case is opened, the LED inside the Smart case will light up red, yellow, or green to indicate the battery status of the earbuds. The LED on the front of the Smart case will indicate the battery status of the Smart case.



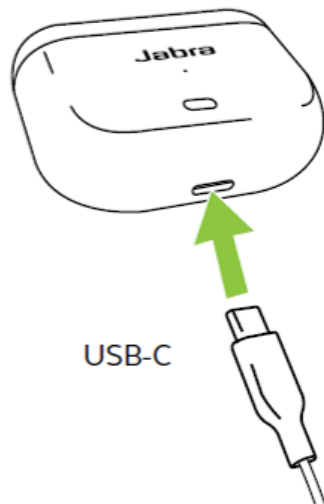
Fast charge the earbuds

When the earbuds are at low battery, 5 minutes in the Smart case will give up to 1 hour of battery. This fast charge option requires that the Smart case has a minimum of 30% battery. You can check the current battery status of the earbuds and Smart case in Jabra Sound+.

Charge the Smart case using the USB cable

It takes up to 3 hours to fully charge the earbuds and the Smart case using the supplied USB cable.

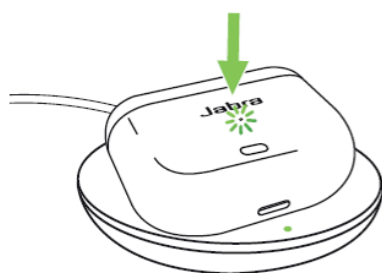
The Smart case uses the standard USB voltage of 5V +/- 0.25V. It is not recommended to charge using a power supply with a higher voltage.



Charge the Smart case using the Jabra wireless charging pad (available as an optional accessory)

Place the Smart case in the center of the Jabra wireless charging pad. The LED on the Smart case will flash to indicate the Smart case is placed correctly. It takes up to 3 hours to fully charge the earbuds and the Smart case using the wireless charging pad. When fully charged, the LEDs on the Smart case and wireless charging pad will turn off.
