

Jabra PanaCast 40 VBS - MS Teams Room

What are the steps for setting up the Jabra PanaCast 40 VBS?

Here is an overview of the steps required to set up the Jabra PanaCast 40 VBS.

1. Install the video bar.
2. Connect the cables, ensuring both the video bar and the touch controller are connected to the same local area network (LAN) or Wi-Fi.
3. Set up the touch controller.
 1. After the device powers on, follow the setup wizard displayed on the touch controller.
 2. During the last step of the configuration, it is necessary to log into the video conferencing account of your service provider.
4. Manage settings and devices locally using the touch controller or remotely using the Web Console or Jabra Plus.

Use the touch controller

1. Go to the **More** menu in the video conferencing app, and select **Settings, Device settings**.
2. The Jabra PanaCast 40 VBS settings screen will be displayed.
3. Go to the **Admin** menu and log in as an administrator. If this is the first login, the default username is *admin* and the password is the *last 6 digits of the serial number of the touch controller*.

Use the Web Console

Enter the IP address of the video bar or the touch controller in a browser. If this is the first time accessing the Web Console, the default username is *admin* and the password is the *last 6 digits of the serial number of the device that is used to access the Web Console*.

Use Jabra Plus

To link the Jabra PanaCast 40 VBS with an organization in Jabra Plus, enter the provisioning code and name the meeting room to identify the Jabra device in Jabra Plus. The provisioning code is generated in Jabra Plus. For more information, go to jabra.com/help/jabraplus.

5. Manage the video settings.
