What is the difference between audio quality for calls or music listening?

Audio quality for calls

Telephony/communication products typically support wideband audio, which is also known as HD (High Definition) voice. HD voice reproduces voice quality so that it sounds crisp, clear, and natural at the receiving end of the call. HD voice provides high quality audio for calls but not for music listening.

Audio quality for music

To get the best possible audio quality for music reproduction, the Jabra product requires two speakers that support music and video streaming in Hi-Fi stereo. All current Jabra Bluetooth products with two speakers support stereo sound. These products typically use the A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile) standard for streaming high quality stereo audio.
